



ACCOMMODATION AND WELFARE POLICY FULL-FEE PAYING OVERSEAS STUDENTS

The College will check the appropriateness of the Local Carer's homestay accommodation as part of the student's enrolment process. Checks will be completed at least once per year, to ensure that the homestay placement is providing a suitable, safe, and supportive environment for the overseas student.

Guidelines and responsibilities of a Local Carer:

The local carer is an important contact person in liaising with the family and the College and serves as a vital link in ensuring each boy has a positive boarding experience. The local carer must:

- Provide suitable homestay accommodation for the overseas student.
- Act as a contact for general, day-to-day issues.
- Be available for the student to stay with during boarders' long weekends and school holidays (if the student is not returning home).
- Be responsible for caring for the student if he is unwell, injured, requires emergency care,
